With the help of VUMC, the Virginia Conference, and the many individuals who have prayed and worked hard along the way, Aisle 7 is also week by week growing in Spirit and strength. With faith, a Godgiven vision, and firm commitment, I believe we will look back on this cooperative effort in the years to come as a shining moment in our church's history.




