### <u>From the Pastor</u>

Life in Jesus Christ can be a beautiful and surprising journey, especially when we consider how quickly things can move from dreams to reality through prayer and faith in our Savior. A year ago the Verona Community Center and a new faith community were a very vague vision in the minds and spirits of members of our congregation.

Today we are on the brink of that vague vision becoming reality.

A year ago we knew nothing of campus pastor Kevin McMullen or the new worship leader for Aisle 7, Ethan Eldred. We had never attempted to start either a community center or a new faith community. We had no idea how many volunteers would help remodel the community center space, or how many people would bring in donations big and small to make all this possible—or how many prayers would be prayed.

A year ago we had no idea where the community center would be located; how much space we would need; what contractors would be involved in creating it; or if the county would even approve its zoning.

## **Worship Leader Hired for Aisle 7 Fellowship**

After a search that resulted in three persons being invited for formal interviews, Ethan Eldred has been hired by the Verona UMC Staff-Parish Relations Committee as Aisle 7 Fellowship's first Worship Leader. Ethan is an experienced worship leader and musician who has also worked in music and theatrical technology and management. A native of Pennsylvania, he and his wife Grace are recent transplants to the area.

Ethan graduated from Messiah College last year with a music degree and spent part of his time in college at a contemporary music program in Nashville with music industry students from other Christian schools. He is also trained in conducting, music theory, composition and arranging, and is proficient on a number of different musical instruments. Ethan shared his faith testimony and played guitar and sang in his interviews.

## The Season of Lent

riginating in the fourth century of the church, the season of Lent spans 40 weekdays beginning on Ash Wednesday and climaxing during Holy Week with Holy Thursday (Maundy Thursday), Good Friday, and concluding Saturday before Easter. Lent was a time of preparation for those to be baptized, a time of concentrated study and prayer before their baptism at the Easter Vigil, the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord early on Easter Sunday. Since these new members were to be received into a living community of Faith, the entire community was called to preparation. Also, this was the time when those who had been separated from the Church would prepare to rejoin the community.

Today, Lent is marked by a time of prayer and preparation to celebrate Easter. Since Sundays celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, the six Sundays that occur during Lent are not counted as part of the 40 days of Lent, and are referred to as the Sundays in Lent. The number 40 is connected with many biblical events, but especially with the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness preparing for His ministry by facing the temptations that could lead him to abandon his mission and calling. Christians today use this period of time for introspection, self examination, and repentance. This season of the year is equal only to the Season of Advent in importance. It is really a preparation to celebrate God's marvelous redemption at Easter, and the resurrected life that we live, and hope for, as Christians.
